Duration

n At least two years' relevant full-time work experience.

n English ability equivalent to an IELTS score of 6.5, where the medium of undergraduate study was not English.

The Programme Structure

The Master of Business Administration is usually studied over a period of 18 months.

- All course materials are provided in flexible learning study modules including related tasks and exercises to enable you to consolidate and harvest learning.
- The Master of Business Administration is divided into two stages, a taught stage consisting of eight modules and a final stage, consisting of a dissertation.
- Most modules are equivalent to 150 guided learning hours of study.
- To gain the respective qualification aims, each module must be successfully completed.
